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FALL 2001 ENROLLMENT SUMMARY

This report summarizes the status and trends in fall enrollment at the University of Missouri's four campuses. Enrollments are presented in a series of six tables. Table 1a summarizes the first-time on-campus headcount by student level for each campus since 1997. Table 1b summarizes the fall total headcount enrollments for each campus and the System for the same time period. Table 2 displays fall 2001 enrollments by campus, student level, and characteristics such as residency, full- and part-time status, and student full-time equivalency. Following Tables 1a-b and Table 2 are a series of tables displaying more detailed enrollment and student characteristics for the System and each individual campus. Tables 3.0-3.4 depict on-campus and off-campus headcount and full-time equivalency enrollments as well as student credit hours by student level. On-campus and off-campus enrollments by residency, full- and part-time status, and student level are shown in Tables 4.0-4.4. Table 5.0 shows enrollments by student level, gender, and ethnic characteristics, and Table 6.0 displays UMKC headcount enrollment in its six-year dentistry and medicine programs.

Technical Notes

These tables provide counts of students enrolled in the fall 2001 on-schedule credit courses of the four campuses of the University of Missouri. Fall 2000 counts are included in the Table 3 series (3.0-3.4) for comparison purposes. The data included in these tables were prepared in the admissions and registration offices at the respective campuses. The data are counts as of the census data at each campus, which is

Tables 1a, 1b and 2: Fall Enrollment History and Summary of Fall 2001 Enrollments

- The University of Missouri had a total enrollment of 56,512 in fall of 2001. This is a 6% increase in enrollment over the past five years.
- UM-Columbia enrolled 42% (23,667 students) of total students at the University of Missouri, UM-St. Louis 26% (14,993 students), UM-Kansas City 23% (12,969 students), and UM-Rolla 9% (4,883 students).
- The University of Missouri enrolled 42,737 undergraduate students (76% of total headcount), 2,715 first professional students (5%), and 11,060 graduate students (19%).
- Eighty-two percent of all students enrolled at the University are Missouri residents.
- Of the 56,512 students enrolled System-wide, 67% are full-time students.

- Total headcount enrollment at the University increased 1% from 56,030 in fall 2000 to 56,512 in fall 2001.
- Undergraduate enrollment was relatively unchanged and graduate enrollment increased by 3% from 2000. First professional enrollment increased by 2%.
- The number of first-time degree seeking freshmen enrolling at the University of Missouri increased by 42 students over fall 2000, an increase of 1%.
- First-time degree seeking graduate students totaled 2,305, an increase of 6% from fall 2000.
- The total FTE enrollments and SCH produced increased by 2%.

Table 3.1: UM-Columbia - Headcount, Full-Time Equivalence, and Student Credit Hours

- Total headcount enrollment at UM-Columbia increased 2% (358 students) from 23,309 in fall 2000 to 23,667 in fall 2001.
- Following a record first-time degree seeking freshman enrollment of 4,226 in fall 2000, there was a 1% decrease in the number of first-time freshmen (4,167) in fall 2001.
- First-time first professional enrollment decreased 6% from the previous year and graduate degree seeking enrollment remained relatively unchanged.
- When all levels were combined, FTE enrollment and SCH produced each increased 1% over fall 2000.

- Total headcount enrollment at UM-Kansas City was 12,969 in fall 2001, a 2% increase over the total of 12,698 in fall 2000. FTE enrollment rose by 4% during the last year.
- Total undergraduate enrollment increased by 3%, and total first-professional enrollment increased by 4% from fall 2000. Graduate enrollment was relatively unchanged.
- Enrollment of first-time degree seeking freshmen increased by 65 students or 9% over fall 2000.

- Total headcount enrollment at UM-Rolla increased from 4,626 students in fall 2000 to 4,883 students in fall 2001, an increase of 6% following two years of steady decline.
- The number of first-time degree seeking freshmen increased 3% from fall 2000 to fall of 2001.
- The number of first-time graduate degree seeking students was 329, an increase of 12% from fall 2000.
- Total FTE enrollment and SCH produced increased by 1% at the undergraduate level while there was a 19% increase at the graduate level.

- UM-St. Louis has the lowest percentage of full-time students (41%) and the highest proportion of Missouri residents (93%) among the four campuses.
- At the undergraduate level, 74% of degree seeking freshmen and sophomores are enrolled full-time, compared to 53% of degree seeking juniors and seniors. Only 20% of graduate students are enrolled full-time.
- Ninety-five percent of undergraduates at UM-St. Louis are Missouri residents, while 83% of graduate students are residents. Of the 163 first professional students, 55% are residents of Missouri.

- Total enrollment at the University of Missouri is 53% women and 47% men. UM-St. Louis has the largest percentage of women (61%) and UM-Rolla has the highest proportion of men (78%).
- The first professional level has an equal proportion of men and women (50%) while students at the undergraduate and graduate levels are more likely to be women (53% and 55% respectively).
- Under-represented minorities (American Indian/Alaskan Native, African-American, and Hispanic) represent 11% of the University of Missouri's total enrollment. UM-Kansas City enrolls the largest proportion (15%) followed by UM-St. Louis (13%), UM-Columbia (8%), and UM-Rolla (6%).
- UM-St. Louis has an African-American enrollment of 1,673 students, 12% of its total, and the largest percentage among the four campuses.
- UM-Kansas City enrolls higher percentages of Asian/Pacific Islanders and Hispanics than the other four campuses at 6% and 3% respectively.
- Although nonresident aliens comprise only 6% of total enrollment at the University of Missouri, they represent 21.3% of the total graduate enrollment. UM-Rolla enrolls the largest percentage of nonresident alien graduate students (54%).
