

UNIVERSITY OF MISSOURI DESIGNATION OF HIPAA COVERED COMPONENTS

The Curators of the University of Missouri (University of Missouri) is a Hybrid Entity in accordance with the HIPAA Privacy, Security and Breach Notification Rules promulgated pursuant to the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 (HIPAA), as amended by the Health Information Technology for Economic and Clinical Health Act of 2009 (HITECH). The University of Missouri does have departments, schools or components that provide covered functions under HIPAA. By making this Designation, only the parts of the University of Missouri performing covered functions are subject to HIPAA.

The University of Missouri has authorized the University of Missouri System Privacy Officer to designate the HIPAA Covered Components of the University of Missouri. A list of the Designated HIPAA Covered Components is attached hereto.
