See Rule 12A-1.038, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.).

Your Consumer's Certificate of Exemption is to be used solely by your organization for your organization's

... purchases and by individuals on behalf of the organization, not taxable, even if the individual will be

The certificate shall include purchases your organization makes. The sale or lease to others of tangible

and collect and remit sales and use tax on such taxable transactions. Note: Churches are exempt from this

requirement except when they are the lessor of real property (Rule 12A-1.075, F.A.C.).

It is a criminal offense to fraudulently present this certificate to evade the payment of sales tax. Under no circumstances should this certificate be used for the personal benefit of any individual. Violators will be liable for

felony. Any violation will require the revocation of this certificate.
